To qualify for admission you need to have:

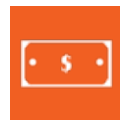
- a Master's degree, or equivalent of at least 240 ECTS in social, economic or political sciences, business, law and/or contemporary history. Relevant work experience may qualify.
- excellent academic results and references
- proven proficiency in English

About our school

The Brussels School of Governance is an alliance between the Institute for European Studies (VUB) and Vesalius College. This Advanced Master in European Integration is a programme of which the degree will be awarded by the Vrije Universiteit Brussel.

What can you study?

After the **4 mandatory courses** Economics of European Integration, Policy-making and Interest Representation in the EU, History and Law of the EU, and Research Methods Lab (in total 21 credits), students take **2 pre-selected policy field specialisations** (24 credits), to be chosen from the list of 5 below.
